## Immunization Requirements

Effective August 22, 1987 the WV Board of Trustees Policy Series 39 requires that all students of the State System of Higher Education under the jurisdiction of the West Virginia Board of Trustees who were born after January 1, 1957, except those exempted by this policy statement, shall be required to provide proof of immunity to measles and rubella. To facilitate the implementation of this policy, the student shall be requested to provide proof of immunity on or before the date of enrollment. Please complete this form and return to:
