WHAT TO BRING AND WHAT NOT TO BRING

1. You SHOULD bring the following:
 - a. Study Lamp
 - b. Alarm Clock
 - c. Dictionary
 - d. Sheets
 - e. Pillow & Pillow case
 - f. Toiletries
 - g. Iron
 - h. Blanket
 - i. Bed Spread
 - j. Mattress Cover (reg. twin size)
 - k. Drapes (38" w x 82" L)
 - l. Curtains (38" W x 82" L)
 - m. 1 set of dress clothes for special occasion dinners

Note: You may want to wait to purchase curtains until you and your roommate have a chance to meet and make a mutual choice. There are mini blinds in all rooms.

2. You MAY bring the following:
 - a. Stereo (must have small speakers and head set)
 - b. Radio or TV
 - c. Computer/Accessories
 - d. Microwave
 - e. Small Refrigerators (cube or 3 ft. tall size)
3. You CANNOT bring the following, which are prohibited in the Residence Halls due to fire safety regulations and pest control.
 - a. Hot Plate
 - b. Electric Skillet
 - c. Electric Crock pot
 - d. George Forman type grill
 - e. Pets or Aquariums over 10 gallons
 - f. Halogen Lamps
 - g. Candles/Incense/open flame items

Note: Please remember that there will be two students per room and space is limited.

LAUNDRY: You will need to bring money for Laundry machines cards. The cost is 1.00 to wash a load of clothes and \$1.00 to dry. Initial cost of card is \$5.00: \$2.00 is for card and 3.00 is for the washer/dryer. Additional money may be added to card. Students may purchase and add money to cards in the main lobby of Sullivan Hall.
